## YOGA DAY CELEBRATION

On the eve of International Yoga Day, held on June 21, 2022, Kovai Sahodaya Schools complex and Yuvabharathi Public School, Coimbatore, collaborated to organise a yoga demonstration. About 1000 students from four schools—Yuvabharathi Public School, PSG Public School, Sri Ramakrishna Central School, and Honey Bunch School, Pollachi—have participated in this programme. The Yoga teachers of Yuvabharathi Public Schools explained the importance of Yoga and demonstrated some postures and their effects on our health. All the students performed yoga for more than 30 minutes. Initially, the Physical Education Director of Yuvabharathi Public School rendered a formal welcome to all the participants, followed by an inaugural speech, which was given by Shri. Girish Eswaran, Principal, PSG Public Schools, Coimbatore. After the yoga demonstration, the students of YBPS gave a vote of thanks.

Yoga is something that has the power to heal the entire body! It is a combined workout of the mind and body that enhances the functions of the brain, reduces stress, and rejuvenates the body and soul. The students of grades IV to XII from PSG public schools performed yoga on June 21st to unite mind and body; thought and action; restraint and fulfillment; harmony between man and nature; and a holistic approach to health and well-being.



## Students Programmes (April 2022 – June 2022)

- Mrs Nithya Ramesh, the Wellness Teacher, had one-to-one counselling sessions with students along with their parents. The session was for 12th-grade band management sections. The sessions were held on April 5th, 6th, and 7th, 2022. A detailed report with the results of the personality, aptitude, and interest tests were presented along with courses or careers suited for the student. Doubts about the courses, careers, and tests were clarified.
- An awareness session about different kinds of abuse was conducted from the 18th to the 20th of April and presented to all the classes 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 12th. The session was conducted by Mrs. Bhuvaneshwari and Mrs. Nithya. The session was about raising awareness about different forms of abuse – emotional abuse, physical abuse, sexual abuse, and cyber abuse; how to deal when the students face such situations; and how to cope. A list of people students can approach in school was presented to them. The session was successfully conducted for girls and boys separately.
- A guidance session for students who are interested in studying abroad was conducted on April 22nd. Ms. Jayasree Girish, an alumna of PSG Public Schools, who has done her Masters in Biomedical Engineering from the University of Glasgow, shared Important information like Statement of Purpose, Recommendations from teachers, Selecting Universities, Courses, Scholarships, Entrance exams like SAT, IELTS, TOEFL, etc., were explained.


