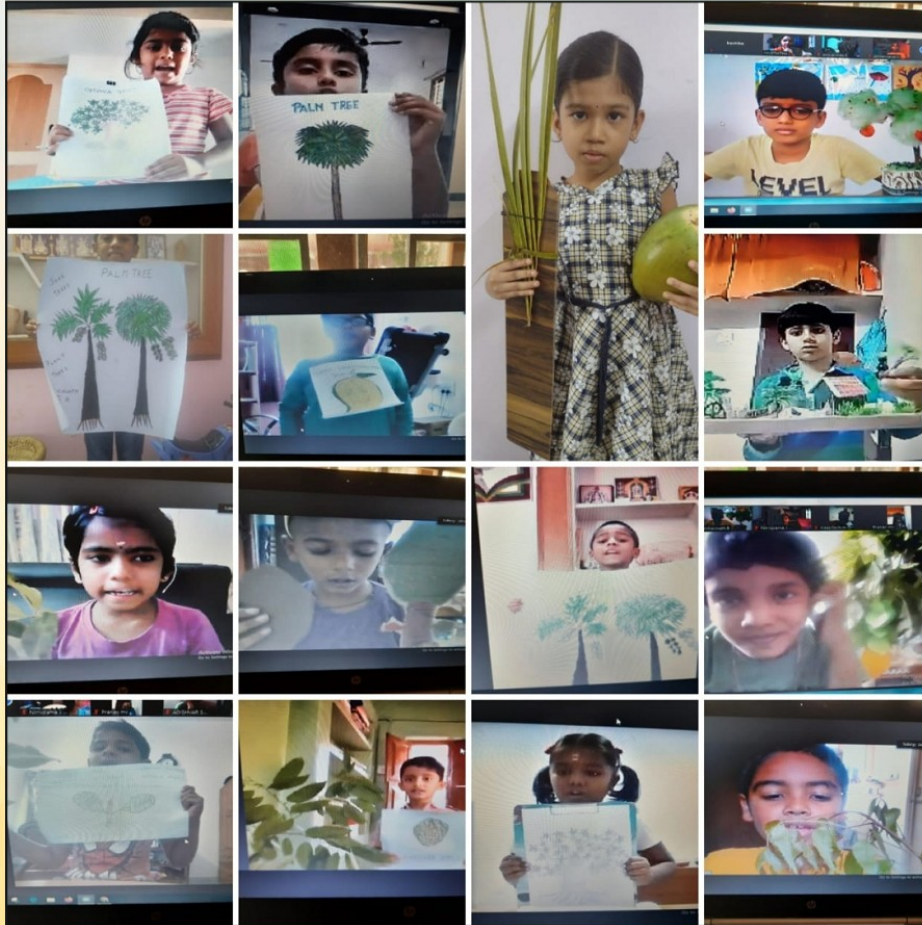

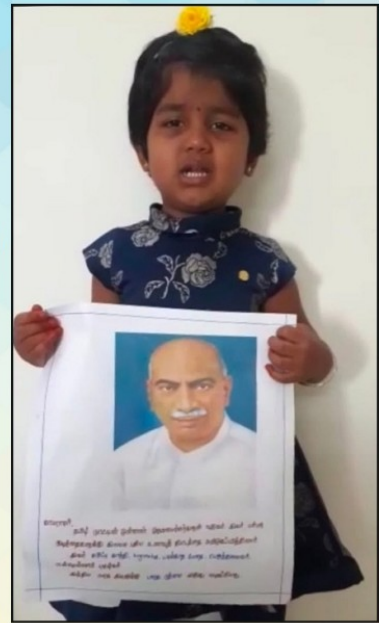
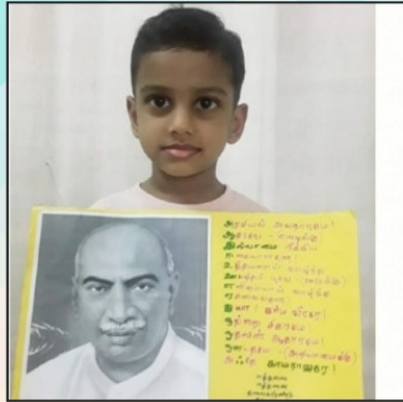
Van Mahotsav Week

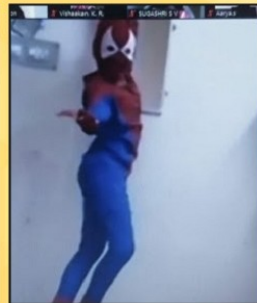
Kamarajar's Birthday

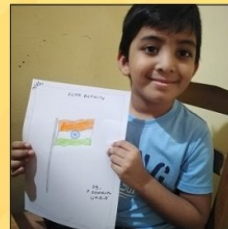
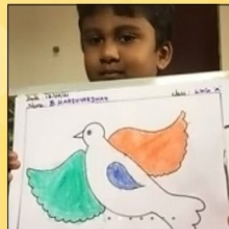
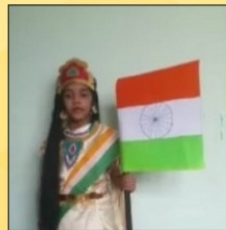
Literary Fest

CBSE CONDUCTED VARIOUS ONLINE COMPETITIONS FOR STUDENTS

Toycathon 2021

Toycathon-2021 is conceived to challenge India's innovative minds to conceptualize novel Toy and Games.

Toycathon 2021 is an inter-ministerial initiative organized by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell with support from All India Council for Technical Education, Ministry of Women and Child Development, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Ministry of MSME, Ministry of Textiles and Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.



Among initial 1.20 lakh ideas 17,000 ideas were selected for grand finale. Grand finale has taken place for three days (22nd, 23rd and 24th of June) in two phases through online mode. Each day there were two sessions one for mentoring at morning and other for evaluation at evening. Phase I ideas were evaluated and shortlisted for third day final phase which included 1567 teams.

During third day Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri.Narendra Modi interacted with the participants on a live session. After phase 2 on 3rd day evaluation, 117 teams were shortlisted as winners for the Toycathon 2021 among which our team "Fantastic Four" led by Keerthana.G, comprising of Krishitha.R and Avanthika.R.S mentored by Ms.Kayalvizhi have emerged as winners.

Teacher Training Workshops

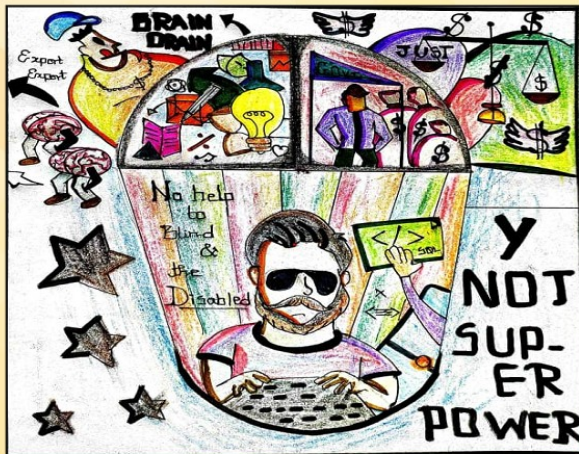
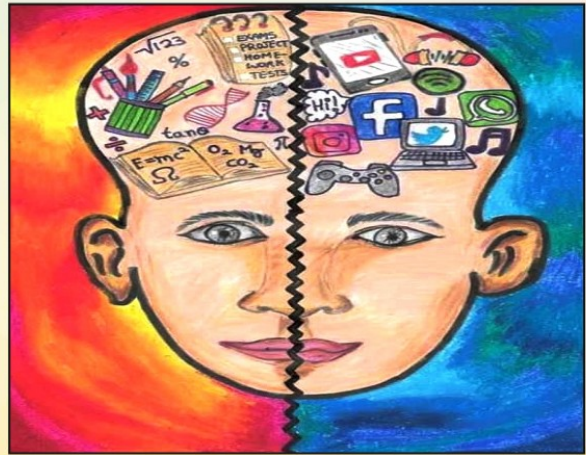

This course was successfully completed by Mr. Jayakrishnan.M (TGT), Ms. Kayalvizhi.S (PGT) and Mrs. Subha.S (PGT)

Cambridge Assessment International Education has organized a workshop on 1st September on the topic "Early Years: Remote teaching and learning strategies" wherein some of our teachers took part and gained knowledge in teaching the young learners. The topic covered the objectives such as maintaining nurturing relationships with children, Environment and resource creation, Exploring technology for curriculum delivery, Monitoring and evaluation of learning, etc. Sarah Waterfield an Experienced Early Years Practitioner and Trainer and Krishna Kulkarni Early Years Specialist were the resource persons.
