The Students of PSGPS visited Yuvabharathi Public School on 9th July 2022 for attending Orientation program conducted by IIT Madras on B.Sc. (Data Science and Programming) at the Venue. Total of 11 students from Grade 11 and Grade 12(Dhanush,Harish,Shailesh,Gokul,Alan,Pranav,ShriNiyathi,Pradeepa,Madhysyam,Jaisujan and Rohit accompanied by Mrs.S.Padmini ,Computer Science Faculty have attended this Orientation session. The Resource person explained about the Structure of the Degree Program, admission procedures, mode of conducting the Class and Exams,. This course is duly to be conducted in online mode and the semester exams in Offline mode in any City Examination Centres, the course is divided into three Categories Foundation Level in 1st year, Diploma Level in 2nd Year and Degree Level in 3rd Third year. To apply the Eligible Criteria is passing Grade 12 and to get admission in IIT for this course the Candidate must take up the Qualifier test with minimum pass mark. Qualifier Test will based on the following Subjects (English, Maths, Computational Thinking and Statics).Course can be taken with breaks in between 6 years duration. This is an opportunity to get into IIT without JEE and this program has a separate Placement Cell. Once if any Candidate Pursue 3years of Graduation and Complete Successfully can become an Alumni Of IIT Madras. Overall the Orientation Session was informative.
