21.06.2024 Our school organized Field Trips for classes VI to XII to various places. The details are as follows:

#### **Grade VI:**

On June 21, 2024, students of Grades 6A (32 students) and 6B (31 students), along with 4 staff members, were taken to **PSG & SONS CHARITIES METALLURGY AND FOUNDRY DIVISION** to explore molding, casting, welding, etc., which would enable them to enhance various learning outcomes related to Science. All the students, along with the teachers, accompanied by the foundry staff members, were taken to the premises with the necessary safety measures. The HOD of the metallurgy division has explained the entire set of procedures and processes related to manufacturing. Students were curious and excited to know more and had asked several questions and got them clarified. After the explanation and deliberation, the students had a group photo session with the foundry staff members.

After the foundry visit, the students had their lunch and were taken to the **Science Regional Centre near Codissia**. There the students were divided into groups and taken into four different galleries along with the teachers. They had experienced How Things Work, the Textile Gallery, and the Fun Science Gallery, along with a 3D theatre and a science park. The children had a thrilling experience in the 3D Science Theatre and Digital Planetarium as they could move back to pre-historic times. At last, the students had an

interactive session in the Innovation Hub with its head. Around 3 p.m., we returned to school with plenty of learning and memories.

### **Grade VII:**

Students of Grade VII were taken to **Salzer Electronics** for field trip on 21.06.2024(FRIDAY). Salzer has been designing and manufacturing high quality **Electrical Relays, Energy Saving Device, Basic Cable Channels**, since 1985.

60 students of Grade VII and 5 staff members namely Mrs. S. Shanmugavadivu , Mrs. Cathaleen Elgiva, Ms. Janani, Mr. Amirta vignesh and Mr. Jawahar accompanied the children. Students are divided into two groups and two leaders took them to each department of Salzer electronics and explained them clearly with demonstration of the following.

- Cable Channels
- Electrical Relays
- Electrical Switches
- Energy Saving Device
- Switch Plates
- Terminal Connectors
- Toroidal Transformers.

Students learnt a lot from this field trip and they thoroughly enjoyed the field trip.

### **Grade VIII:**

Students of Grade VIII were taken to **KG Denim Fabrik Limited** and Sennimalai Murugan Temple.

The trip began at 7:30am and the students of 8<sup>th</sup> A and B were accompanied by Mrs. Geethalakshmi, Mrs. Dhanya Navin, Mr. Santhosh Shanthakumar and Mr. Mani. At KG Denim Factory visited 6 departments as follows:

- Yarn conditioning plant
- Dyeing and Sizing
- Weaving
- Mercerizing

- Curing & Strengthening
- Inspection & Packing

We observed the process of converting cotton fibers into Yarn, which is then used to weave Denim. The process is as follows:

- Cotton
- Blending
- Spinning
- Dyeing
- Weaving
- Coating & Shrinkage
- Quality control and Packaging

The students observed that they are using very less amount of water (6 ltr/mtr.) for washing and dyeing the fabrics. They are using only sustainable products. Every year they are honored with Gold Rated Go Green Certificate for greenery. After that students visited Sennimalai Murugan temple, Half an hour from Perundhurai Denim factory and had the Darshan of Lord Muruga. Students enjoyed the trip very well.

#### **Grade IX:**

The students of Grade IX were taken to **Pillur Dam** for field trip. 55 students, escorted by five teachers, went on the trip. They visited the Canada Power House and Kundah. They learned about three major machines: generators, shafts, and turbines. They also learned about the working mechanism in detail with the help of the department heads. They explained about the production of electricity in a day (1 lakh units) and how it is transformed to the Thudiyalur Electric Board. Finally, they visited the Pillur Dam and explored the beauty of nature. The students gained a lot of information and enjoyed the trip.

#### **Grade X:**

Students of Grade X were taken to **Ooty**, also known as Udhagamandalam, nestled in the Nilgiri Hills of Tamil Nadu.

By 11:00 am, students reached **The Radio Astronomy Centre in Ooty**, that stands as a beacon of scientific exploration in the realm of radio astronomy. The experts at RAC provided a comprehensive overview of how radio waves from celestial objects are received and analyzed to study their properties.

Next the students visited the **Cosmic Ray Laboratory at Ooty**. The laboratory focuses on studying cosmic rays, which are high-energy particles originating from outer space. Researchers at the laboratory use detectors and instruments to measure cosmic ray flux, energy spectra, and arrival directions.

By 2:00 pm we reached **The Indian Institute of Soil and Water Conservation (IISWC)**, it is an esteemed research organization under the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), focusing on soil and water conservation efforts across India.

After the lunch, students were taken to Tea and chocolate factory in Ooty, Children learnt about the process of tea and chocolate production. The factory is situated at an altitude of 1839 meters and spread over an acre on Doddabetta Road

Our trip included educational visits to a tea plantation and a chocolate factory. At the plantation, we learned about the process of tea cultivation and production, from plucking to packaging. Similarly, the chocolate factory tour fascinated us with its insights into chocolate making, from cocoa bean to the finished product. Students and teachers purchased tea and chocolate.

It was an enriching blend of natural beauty, cultural immersion, educational insights, and recreational activities. We returned with fond memories and newfound knowledge.

### **Grade XI Science:**

On 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024 Thursday, 40 students from Grade XI Science and 5 teachers namely Mrs.L.Jeevitha, Mrs.M.Veena, Mrs.Bhanu Rekha, Mr.M.Pushparaj and Mr.Santhosh Kumar are accompanied the children for a trip to **Trivandrum (Kerala)**.

First day we went to **Vikram Sarabhai Space museum (VSSM)**, Thiruvananthapuram, there we celebrated International Yoga day. The



Space museum show cases the history and achievements of Indian Space Programme and also showcase a full scale model of Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV), its heat shield and the fourth stage solid motor of ASLV. The scaled down models of launch vehicles PSLV, GSLV, GSLV Mk III and ATV are also erected in Space Museum premises. After that we visited Trivandrum Zoo and Kovalam Beach.
